Dear representatives of the International Civil Society:

In the context of the International Year of Youth proclaimed by the United Nations, starting August 12th 2010, we invite you to the World Youth Conference (WYC 2010), to be held in Mexico from August 23rd to the 27th.

The WYC Mexico 2010 will have three main events that will be linked together; each one of them representing the three actors involved in strengthening the participation of youth in the development for the future: the NGO Global Meeting, the Government's Forum and the Legislator's Forum.

The Conference will start with the NGO Global Meeting. In this meeting approximately 400 NGO will be represented, two of each United Nations member country, with one Delegate each. The WYC Mexico 2010 main objective will be the creation of a declaration that represents the voice of the world's youth, concerning the main 11 subjects of the Conference: poverty and exclusion, employment, education, technology and innovation, health, gender equality, security, social justice and human rights, sustainable development, international migration, citizen's participation and incidence, and global cooperation.

The applications to become a Delegate in the NGO Global Meeting are now open, and will be until April 9th.
